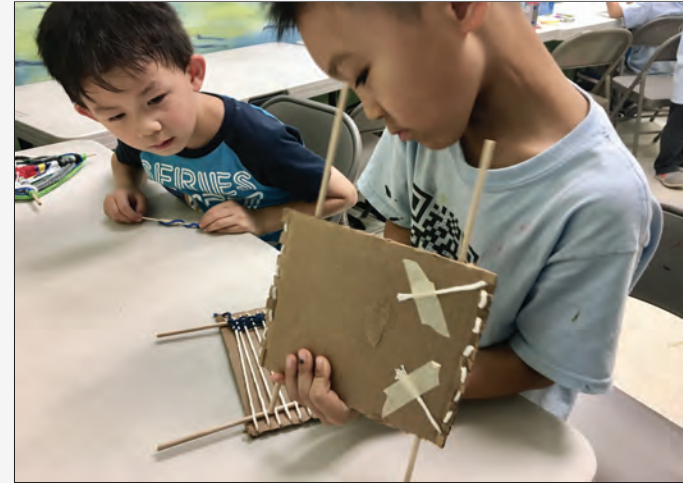
## Pop Art
